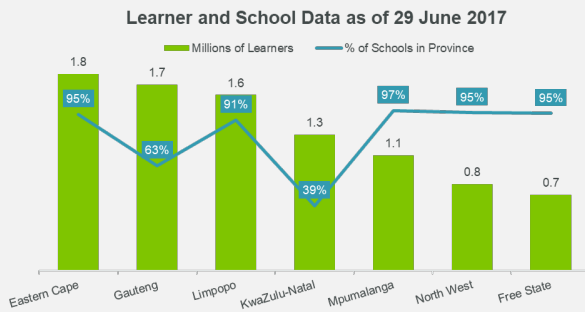


DATA DRIVEN DISTRICTS UPDATE

The DDD Programme has seen significant growth in the reach, speed, completeness and consistency of the data on the dashboard. The number of learners has grown from 2,3 million in 2016 to over 9 million in 2017.

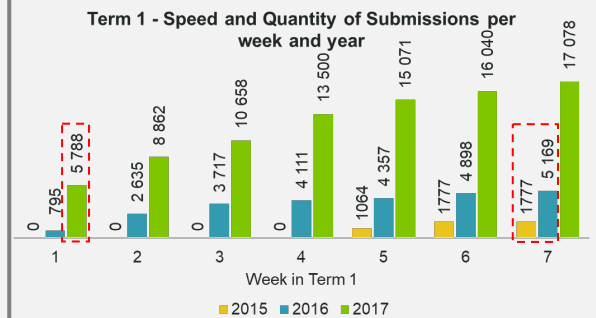
REACH

More than 9 million learner records are on the dashboard representing 70% of learners in South Africa



SPEED

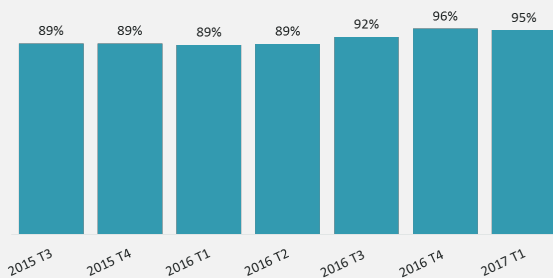
Data collection is faster than ever. More schools submitted data in the first week of Term 1 2017 than in the seventh week of 2015 and 2016



COMPLETENESS

The quality of the data continues to improve as data completeness now stands over 95%

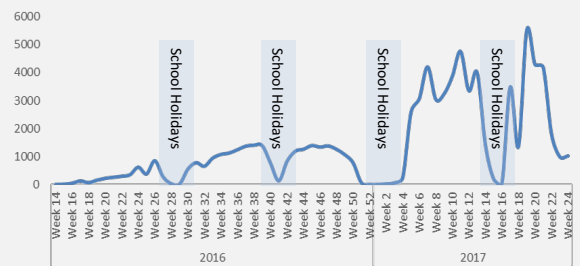
Average Data Completeness per Term as of 29 June 2017



CONSISTENCY

In the first week of May over 5,500 schools submitted interim data. In Mpumalanga, nearly 85% of schools submit data every week

Weekly Valistractor Interim Submissions as of 29 June 2017



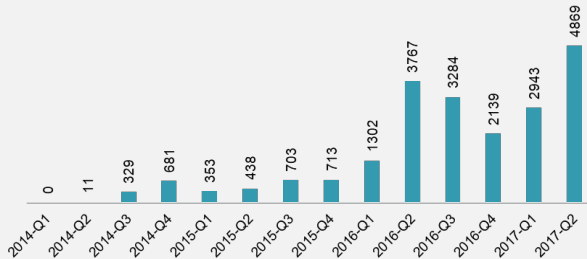
DATA DRIVEN DISTRICTS UPDATE

The number of active users is increasing year-on-year, from 353 in 2015 to 4,869 today

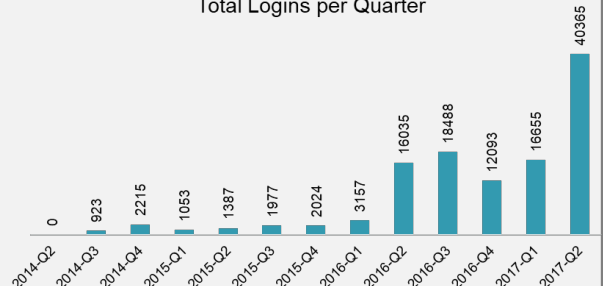
Active Users per Quarter

Total Logins per Quarter

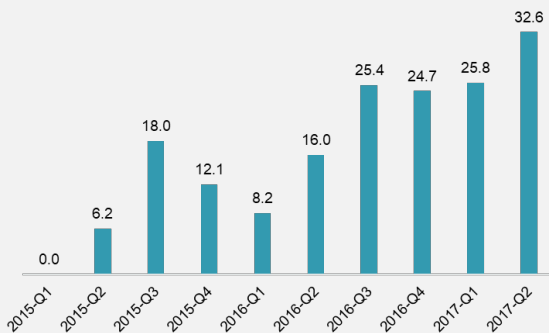


*Active users: User created and logged in at least once in that quarter
